It also presupposes the effort for a more just social order where tensions are better able to be reduced and conflicts more readily settled by negotiation." (CCC, 1939, 1940) Solidarity also reminds us of the Church's preferential option for the poor. How we treat those most vulnerable and those most in need reflect the moral character of our society. 
